

Gilbert Harry as I always knew him was certainly a top cowboy. He always had a good cow horse which he rode. He could work alone or with a crew equally well. He often worked gate, on horseback! At weaning time and is commented on in Art Hagon's book "Ranch Hand".

Gilbert used to train his Mountain race horse "Blue Jay" down a steep logback just outside the Circle 5 gate.

Antoine Harry was just like his brother Gilbert cowboying. The difference was that Antoine would ride any horse no matter how bad it was. If Gilbert had a horse that wanted to buck he immediately gave to Antoine to straighten out. Antoine & I drove 100 steers from Circle 5 home ranch to Flying U meadows in January 1952 for Frank Leamer to feed. Six days drive between 30° & 40° below Fahrenheit & rode home in two days. In April Gilbert & I went & brought the steers home. Much nicer weather.
